## Call for Abstracts

To recognize IDSNY adult and pediatric ID fellows' research accomplishments, we will again have a fellow scientific research competition and award as part of the annual symposium.

### Submission requirements:

- First author must be a current pediatric or adult ID fellow in the New York Metropolitan area.
- Fellows must be members of the IDSNY (<http://www.idsny.org> – membership is free for fellows).
- If selected for an award, fellows must be able to present their work as a virtual talk with slides **on May 10, 2022 via a Zoom presentation**.
- Fellows may submit any abstract regardless of prior or intended future regional or national presentations.
- Research must have been performed within the prior year.
- **No case presentations are accepted unless part of a broader research study**. Case presentations should be saved for Intercity Rounds.

### Abstract selection for presentation and criteria for cash award:

- A committee made up of IDSNY board members will review the abstracts based on scientific merit. Two abstracts will be selected for awards.
- Winners of the competition will receive an award and a cash prize.
- Please note that all accepted abstracts will be made available online during the meeting. We ask you to include contact information (email) for the presenting author.
